Troop Camping Program

For over 85 years, local scout groups have been coming to Baiting Hollow for summer camp. Many troops choose Baiting Hollow for its convenient location; but the Hollow is worth traveling to. Many units from out of state and other councils also make it their prime destination. More and more local troops have been adding a second week of summer camp for younger scouts and those who want more scouting in their summer. If you are a Scoutmaster in Suffolk County, you probably know the Hollow during the winter, but it is a different place in the summer. Our staff is exceptional, and the summer camp activities are all right here.

Provisional camp

You may still come to camp at Baiting Hollow this summer even if your troop is not camping. Be part of our Provisional Troop where the camp provides the adult leadership. Come by yourself, or come with your patrol and you will have the opportunity to do all of the programs that a home troop can do. Provisional camping also allows scouts to return for more than one week of camp during the summer. Provisional camp is offered for five weeks during summer camp. **(There is an additional discount of \$25.00 each week you attend after the first week)**

Bridge camp (August 1st-7th)

Bridge camp is a provisional program for scouts who have just bridged over from Webelos. During the day you will be involved with our Brownsea "first year camper program" At night, you will be in your own campsite with other scouts your own age. You will have a chance to work on Totin Chip, Fireman Chit, Baiting Hollow naturalist and participate in all of the other camp programs. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to work on your first merit badge.

Bike Camp

July 11th—18th

If you enjoy biking, come ride with us throughout eastern Long Island. Each night the group will stay at a different location. While on your trek, you will have ample opportunity to stop and enjoy the various locales on the East End. The Scouts arrive back in camp on Friday afternoon in time to clean-up, have dinner and participate in the closing campfire. This is a provisional program which means the camp provides the leadership. You bring your bike, helmet and personal equipment. Camp provides the tents, food and a chase vehicle to haul the equipment.



Eagle Camp

August 15th -20th

If you're at least First Class, 13 years old and need help with some of the required merit badges, then our Trail to Eagle camp is just your speed. During the week, counselors will be available for all the Eagle required merit badges. Some badges require 3 months worth of work and have requirements that must be completed and worked on before arriving at camp. PLAN EARLY. One of the highlights of the week is the opportunity to meet your District Advancement Chairman and review some of your plans with him. One evening during the week is spent discussing Eagle Scout Service Projects and the Eagle Application. You are working on Scouting's highest award – no shortcuts will be taken during camp. Be Prepared. Your parents are invited to the closing banquet on Friday night to witness your accomplishments.



Aquatics Camp

August 1st– 7th

This program is designed for Scouts who enjoy aquatic activities. This week will focus on higher level activities and participants must be able to pass the BSA swim test on the day of arrival. Scouts will have the opportunity to go on an overnight canoe trip, participate in a boaters safety course and work towards Boardsailing BSA, Kayaking BSA, Mile Swim BSA and Lifeguard BSA.



Counselor in Training Program

June 30 – July 23

Enroll as a CIT if you are at least 14 years old by July 1, 2010. Half your day will be spent working next to experienced staff members getting a hands-on look at the camp's programs. The second half of your day will be spent on individual advancement and achievements including an opportunity to work on merit badges. Individuals who graduate from the CIT program will then have the opportunity to be considered for placement as a member of our Junior Staff Intern Program. If selected, Scouts can continue their training at no cost and spend the remainder of the summer working with our camp staff.
